Parents are required to bring their member into the Club lobby for pre-screen. When picking up your child, you may call from the parking lot and we will send your child out or you may come into the lobby and we will page him for you. Please wear a mask and practice social distancing during drop-off and pick-up times.

### Drop-off and Pick-up

Members may be dropped off starting at 3:00 pm and must be picked up no later than 7:00 pm during evening hours. During day hours, members may be dropped off starting at 7:45 am and picked up no later than 4:00 pm.

### Drop-off and Pick-up

Members may be dropped off starting at 1:30 pm and must be picked up no later than 7:00 pm during evening hours. During day hours, members may be dropped off starting at 7:45 am and picked up no later than 4:00 pm.

### Drop-off and Pick-up

Hours remain the same as level 2. Members attending any school that is shut down due to COVID, may not attend for 14 days.

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**Does my child need to bring his own mask, or will one be provided?**

The Club will provide each boy a mask each day. If they have their own and would prefer to wear it, that is fine.

**Will meals be provided at the Club?**

Yes. Snack and dinner will be provided during evening hours and breakfast, lunch, and snack during day hours.

**May my child leave the Club and return the same day?**

No. For the safety of all members and staff once a member leaves the program they may not return until the following day.

**May my child bring personal items?**

Members are encouraged to leave personal items at home except for water bottles.

**Does my child need to bring a water bottle?**

Water will be provided, but boys will be allowed to bring a personal water bottle.

**Will staff be able to assist with e-learning/technology?**

Our program will offer one 45-minute rotation each day for members to spend on e-learning/technology. Our staff are not certified teachers but will assist as much as possible.

**How do I register my child for your program?**

Once a renewal application has been submitted, parents may call our front office to register for the month of September. To serve those in most need, we ask that parents commit to having their child attend on a regular basis or they may lose their spot in the program. We are currently not accepting new members.

**What measures will the Club be taking to prevent spread of illnesses?**

We are committed to providing a safe experience for your child and our staff. During this time, we will be taking the following preventative measures:

- Temperatures will be taken from all staff and children upon check-in.
- Staff and members will wear masks inside the building.
- Disinfecting of high contact areas throughout the day and at the end of each day.
- Planned/spaced hand washing for members between rotations before meals and after bathroom use.
- Programming that is social distancing conscious.
