How do I register my child for your 2020-2021 school year program?

Once an application has been submitted, parents may call our front office to register. To serve those in most need, we ask that parents commit to having their child attend on a regular basis or they may lose their spot in the program. New members must attend a new members meeting before attending the Club.

LEVEL 2

Parents are required to bring their member into the Club lobby for pre-screen. Members must attend school on their scheduled school days to attend the Club.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Members may be dropped off starting at 1:30 pm and must be picked up no later than 7:00 pm during evening hours. During day hours, members may be dropped off starting at 7:45 am and picked up no later than 4:00 pm. When picking up your member, you may call from the parking lot and we will send him out or you may come into the lobby and we will page him for you. Please wear a mask and practice social distancing during drop-off and pick-up times.

Do you provide transportation from schools?

We are currently providing transportation from Valley View Elementary with a tentative start date of October 6. Please watch our website and Facebook for updates and future additions.

Do members need to bring their own mask, or will one be provided?

The Club will provide each boy a mask each day. If they have their own and would prefer to wear it, that is fine.

Will meals be provided at the Club?

Yes. Snack and dinner will be provided during evening hours and breakfast, lunch, and snack during day hours.

May members leave the Club and return the same day?

No. For the safety of all members and staff once a member leaves the program they may not return until the following day.

May members bring personal items?

Members are encouraged to leave personal items at home except for water bottles.

Do members need to bring a water bottle?

Water will be provided, but boys will be allowed to bring a personal water bottle.

Will staff be able to assist with e-learning/technology?

Parents are encouraged to contact our education staff to discuss a plan for their member to be successful in school. Our staff will track progress, assist with logging in and help with homework (to the best of our abilities) and offer an incentive to encourage members to accomplish their goals. We will not force a Club member to work on e-learning at any point during their time spent at the Club.

What measures will the Club be taking to prevent spread of illnesses?

We are committed to providing a safe experience for your child and our staff. During this time, we will be taking the following preventative measures:

- Temperatures will be taken from all staff and children upon check-in.
- Staff and members will wear masks inside the building.
- Disinfecting of high contact areas throughout the day and at the end of each day.
- Planned/spaced hand washing for members between rotations before meals and after bathroom use.
- Programming that is social distancing conscious.
