### How do I register my child for your 2020-2021 school year program?

An application and Covid waiver must be completed by the parents along with a \$12 membership fee (scholarships are available). Since spots are limited, we ask that parents commit to having their child attend on a regular basis or they may lose their spot in the program. New members must attend a new member's meeting before attending the Club.

# LEVEL 2

Members will have their temperature taken upon arriving at the Club and must wear a mask while in the building. Anyone with a temperature higher than 100.4 will have their parents/guardians contacted and must be picked up right away. Members must attend school on their scheduled school days to attend the Club.

#### Drop-off and Pick-up

Members may be dropped off starting at 1:30 pm and must be picked up no later than 7:00 pm during evening hours. During day hours, members may be dropped off starting at 7:45 am and picked up no later than 4:00 pm. When picking up your member, you may call from the parking lot and we will send him out or you may come into the lobby and we will page him for you. Please wear a mask and practice social distancing during drop-off and pick-up times.

# LEVEL 3

When a school moves to level 3, Club members who are students and attending that school will not be allowed to attend the Club For Boys during the duration of the level 3 time period unless new information arises that substantially changes the situation. Such decision is exclusively at the discretion of the Executive Director.

**Do you provide transportation from schools?**

We are currently providing transportation from Valley View and Rapid Valley. Please watch our website and Facebook for updates and future additions.

**Do members need to bring their own mask, or will one be provided?**

The Club will provide each boy a mask each day. If they have their own and would prefer to wear it, that is fine.

**Will meals be provided at the Club?**

Yes. Snack and dinner will be provided during evening hours and breakfast, lunch, and snack during day hours.

**May members leave the Club and return the same day?**

No. For the safety of all members and staff once a member leaves the program they may not return until the following day.

**Will staff be able to assist with e-learning/technology?**

Parents are encouraged to contact our education staff to discuss a plan for their member to be successful in school. Our staff will track progress, assist with logging in and help with homework (to the best of our abilities) and offer an incentive to encourage members to accomplish their goals. We will not force a Club member to work on e-learning at any point during their time spent at the Club.

**What measures will the Club be taking to prevent spread of illnesses?**

We are committed to providing a safe experience for your child and our staff. During this time, we will be taking the following preventative measures:

- Anyone entering the building beyond the front lobby must have their temperature taken. Anyone with a temperature higher than 100.4 will not be able to stay at the Club.
- Staff, volunteers, and members will wear masks in common areas inside the Club.
- Disinfecting of high contact areas throughout the day and at the end of each day.
- Hand sanitizer is available in all areas. Members are encouraged to sanitize in each area and wash hands before mealtimes.
- Programming that is social distancing conscious.

**What is your protocol for members and quarantine?**

Members should not attend the Club if they must quarantine from school because of a close contact, live with someone who is positive or show symptoms themselves.
