The Club for Boys announces its Afterschool Meal Program for boys who are members. Boys may become members if they are ages 6-17, complete an application form and submit a birth certificate. Members will be served an afterschool snack from 3:00-4:00 PM and dinner from 5:00-5:45 PM, Monday through Friday. On days when school is not in session, Monday through Friday, breakfast will be served from 8:30-9:15 AM and lunch from 12:00 PM-1:00 PM and an afternoon snack at the regular time. This program starts on September 6, 2022 and ends on May 24, 2023. Meals and snacks will be provided for members at The Club for Boys, 320 N 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Rapid City, SD 57701. No meals will be served on: October 3 and 31; November 11, 24 and 25; December 5 and 26; January 2 and 9; February 6; March 6 and 13; and April 3.
