

Privacy Policy

The following Privacy Policy governs all pages hosted at theclubforboys.org, those hosted through our online donation area and Facebook as well as personal information submitted to the Club for Boys via other means.

Privacy of Information/Collection of Information

When you are on the Club for Boys' website and are asked for personal information, you are sharing that information with the Club alone, unless stated otherwise or required by law. The Club may collect general information regarding online visitors, including IP address, browser and domain information, and may also monitor and track information such as visitor usage patterns of our website using standard site tracking software.

We are aware of and sensitive to the issue of unsolicited email ("spam"); therefore, the Club will never rent, trade or sell your email address.

Personally Identifiable Information

The Club for Boys collects personal information from website visitors and other supporters only when they make a donation online or offline, or otherwise participate in our online community. Our web server does not automatically recognize or collect personal information based on your email address. The Club provides you with the ability to unsubscribe to any email list and to request deletion of any personal information maintained by the Club; the email address for this is contact@theclubforboys.org.

Use of Information

The Club for Boys uses the information you submit voluntarily to us to send you electronic communications such as emails, and various printed publications or mail appeals, and to help administer and improve our website.

The Club for Boys does not exchange, rent or sell our mailing list.
